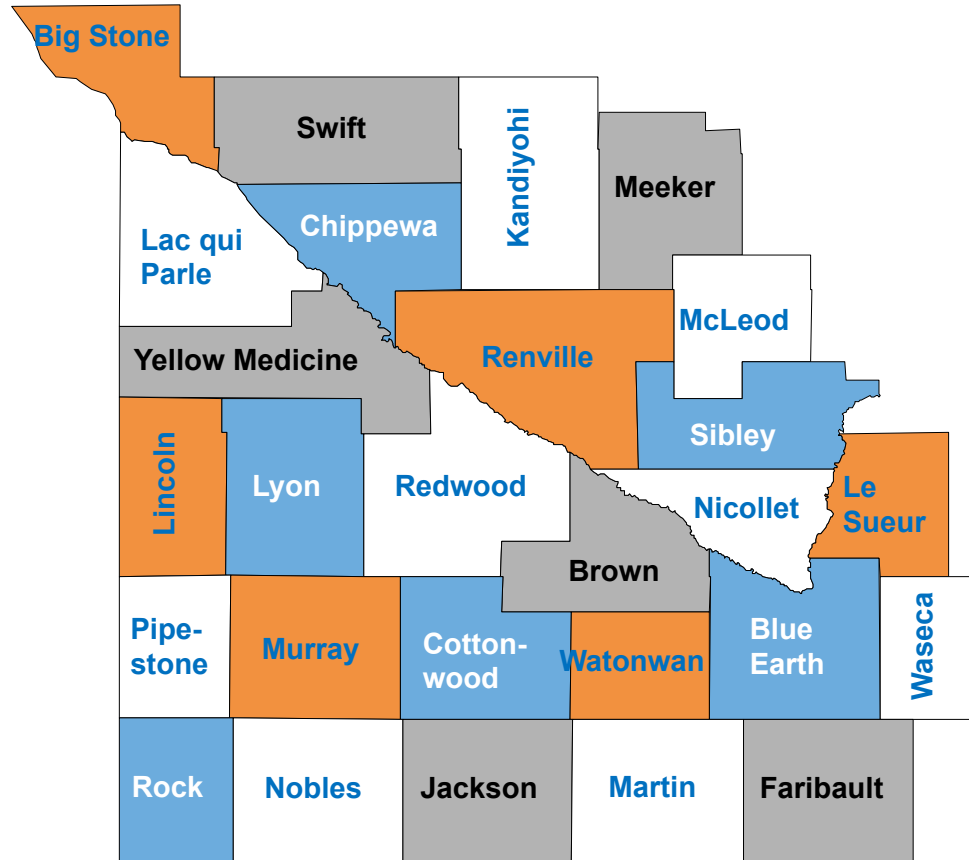

Consequences

Alcohol

Tobacco

- The 2015 rate of lung, bronchus, and trachea cancer deaths for the Southwest Region was 52 per 100,000 population—slightly higher than the state rate of 45
- It is estimated that 90% of lung cancer deaths among males and 79% among females are smoking-related
- According to the Surgeon General's report, smoking harms nearly every organ in the body, causing many diseases (including coronary heart disease—the leading cause of death in the US)



Minnesota Student Survey

2016 MSS

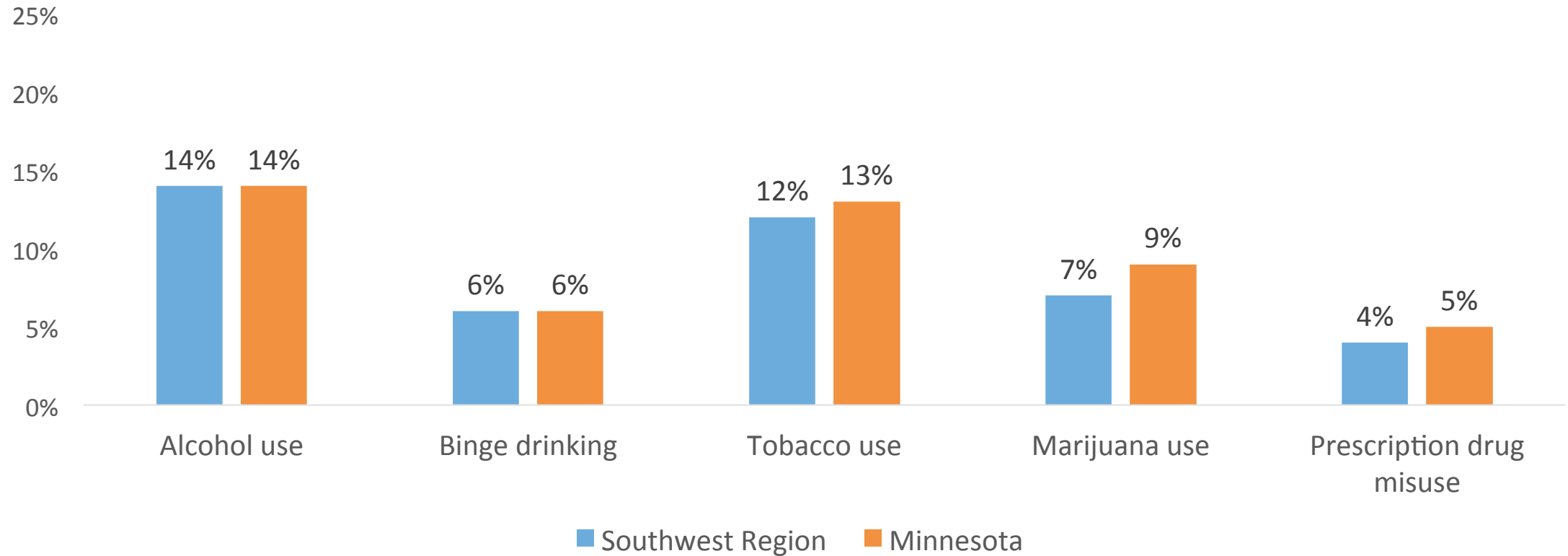
- Administered in the first half of 2016 to public school students in grades 5, 8, 9, and 11
- 85.5% of public operating school districts participated
- Overall participation across the four grades was approximately 66% of total enrollment
- **Southwest Region students make up 9.3% of the overall statewide sample**

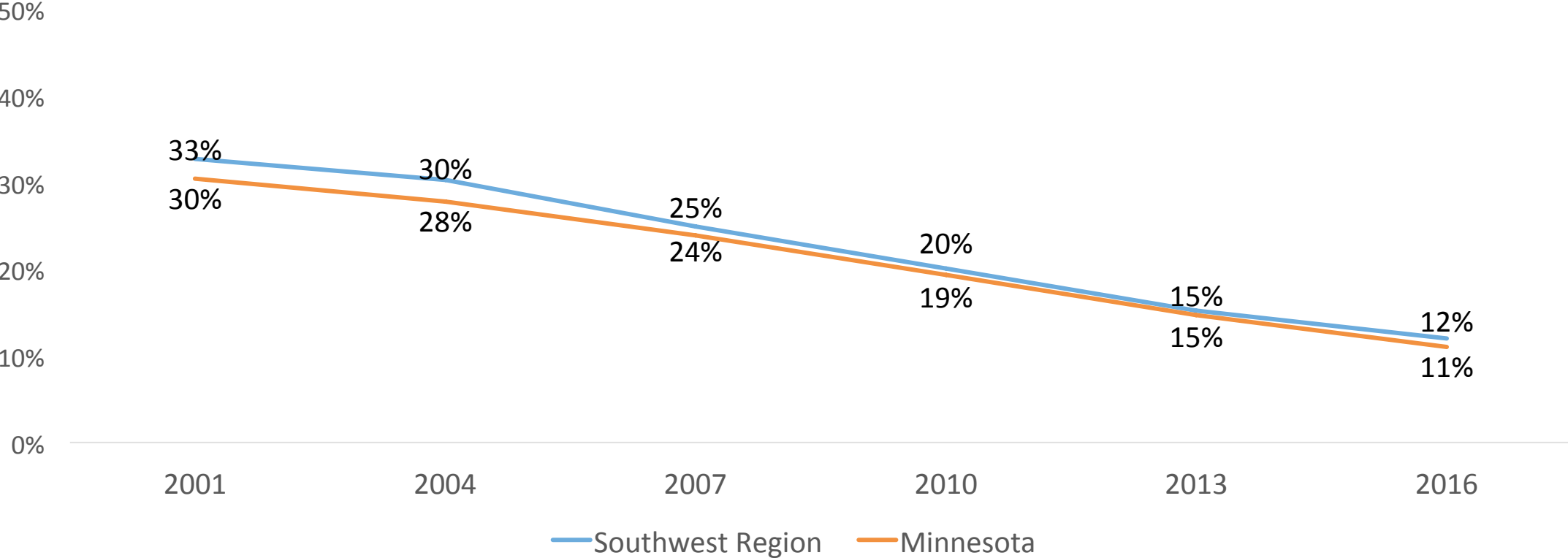
8th, 9th, + 11th Graders Reporting Past-Month Substance Use, 2016 MSS



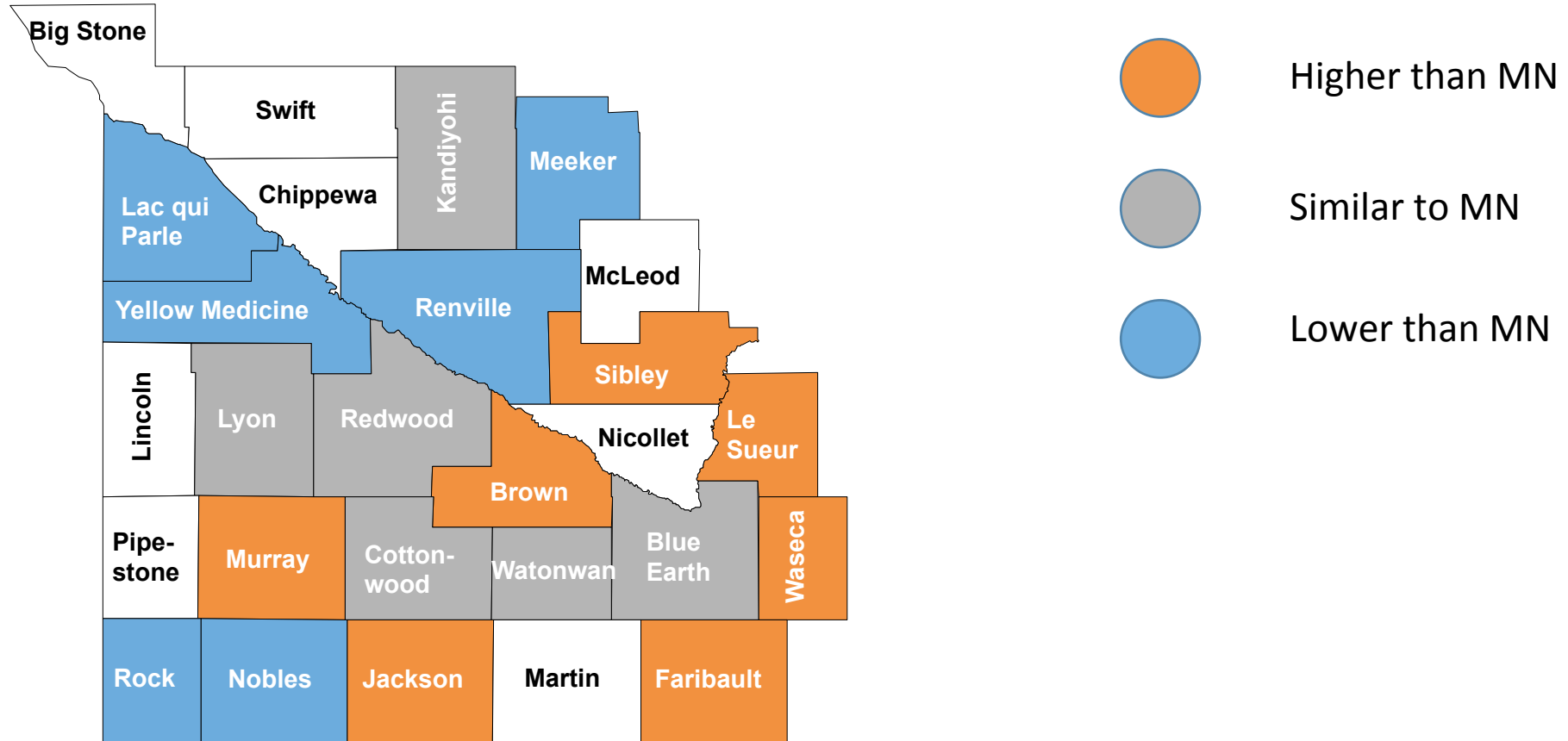
Past-Month Alcohol Use

9th Graders Reporting Any Past-Month Alcohol Use, by Year, MSS



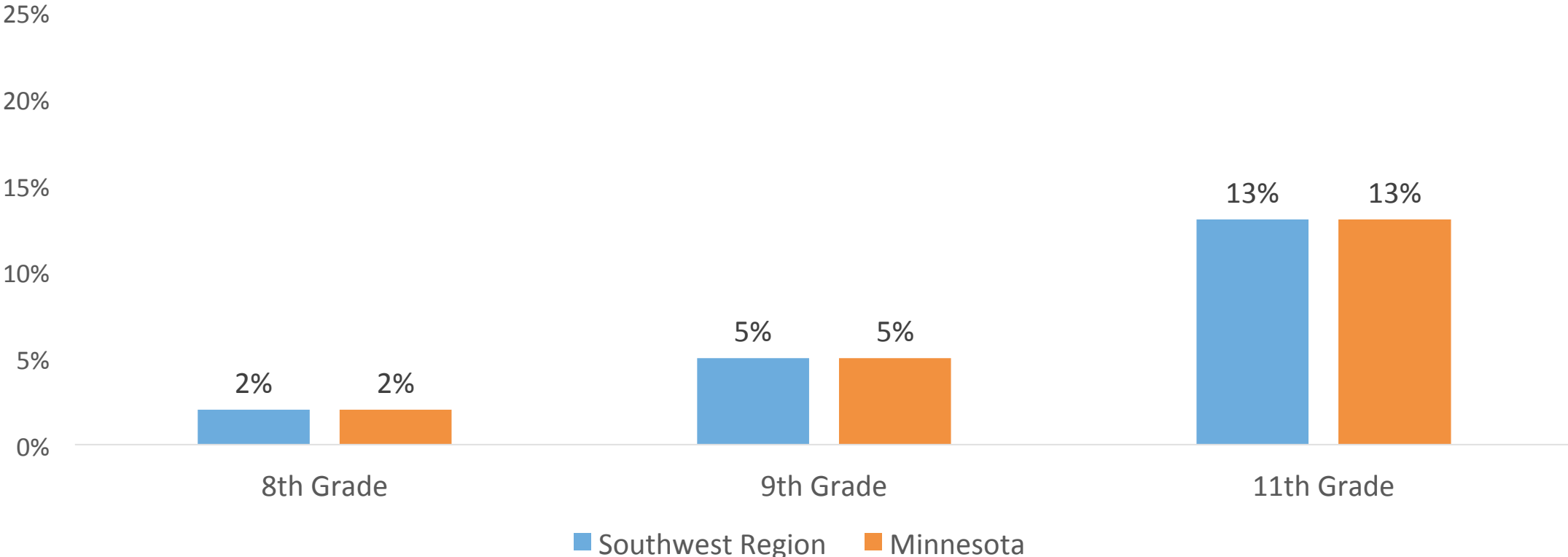
Past-Month Alcohol Use



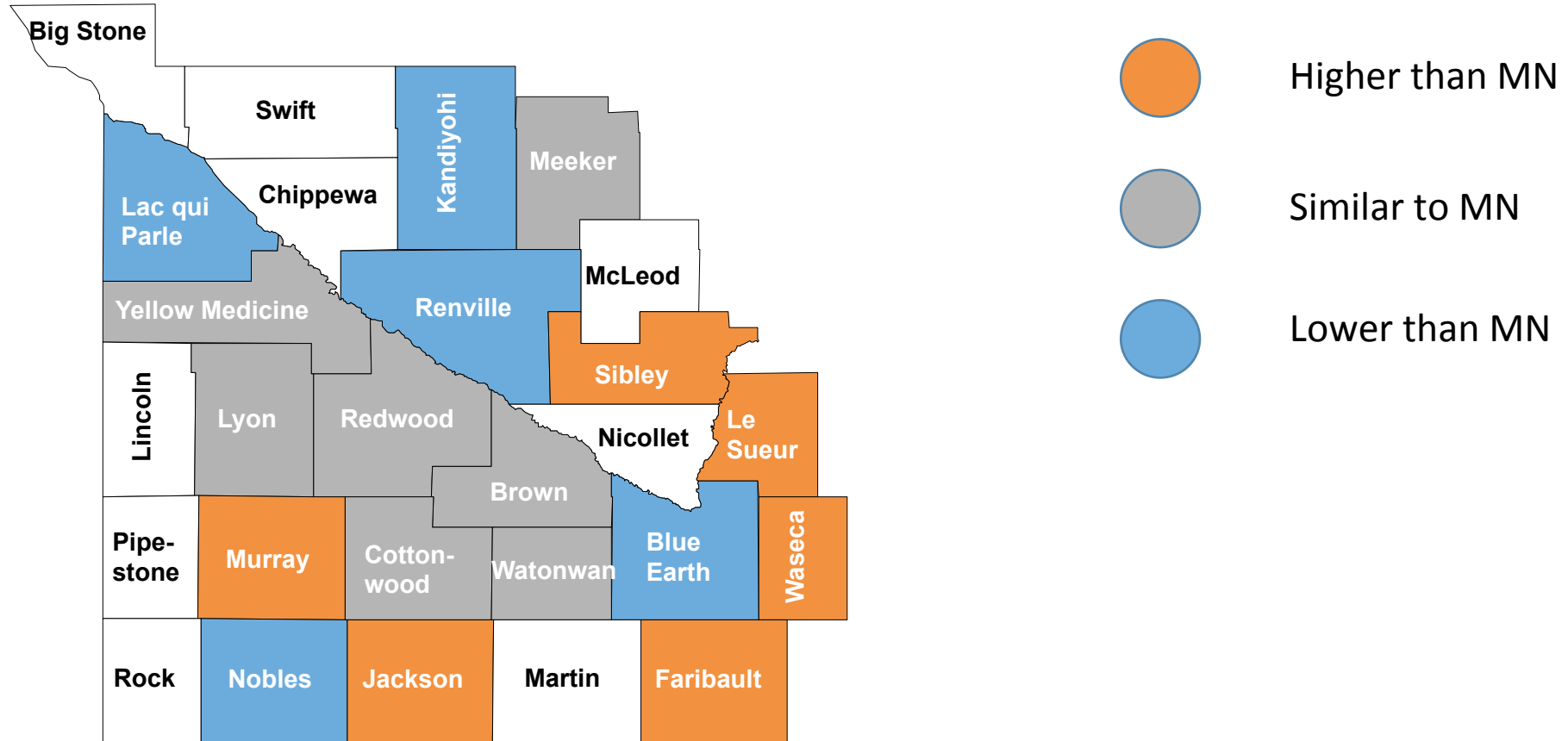
Past-Month Binge Drinking

Students Reporting Past-Month Binge Drinking, 2016 MSS



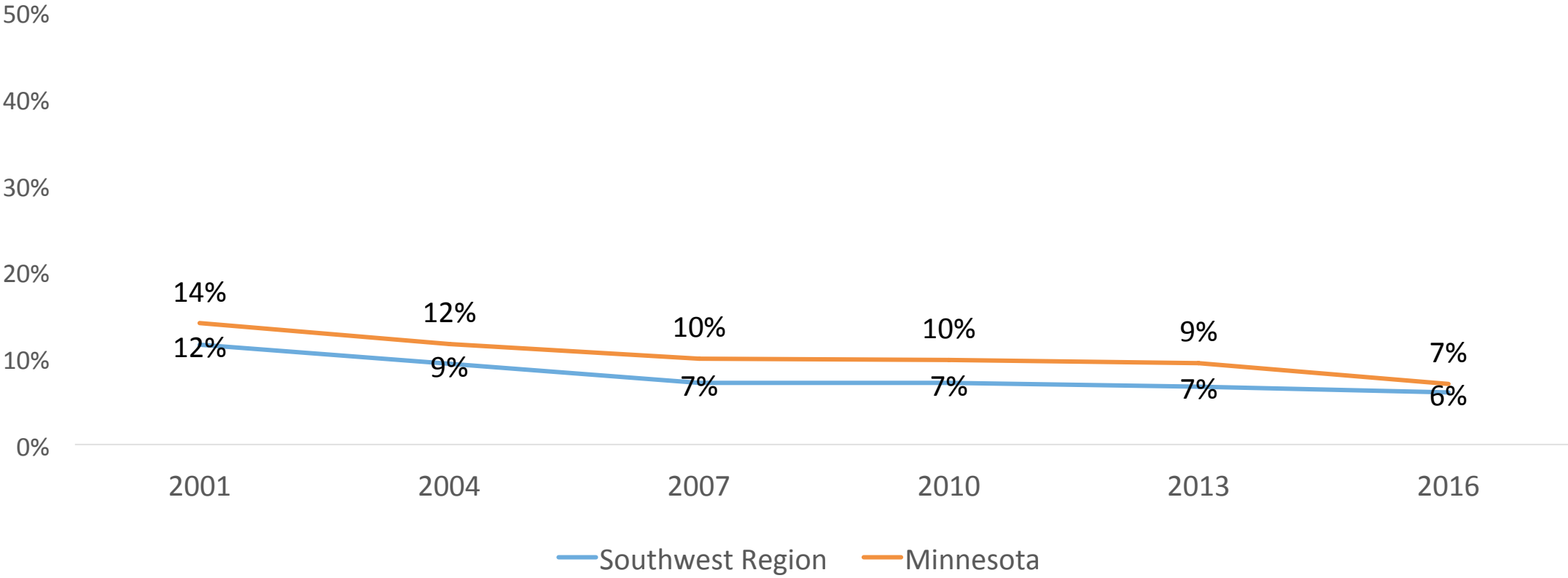
Past-Month Binge Drinking



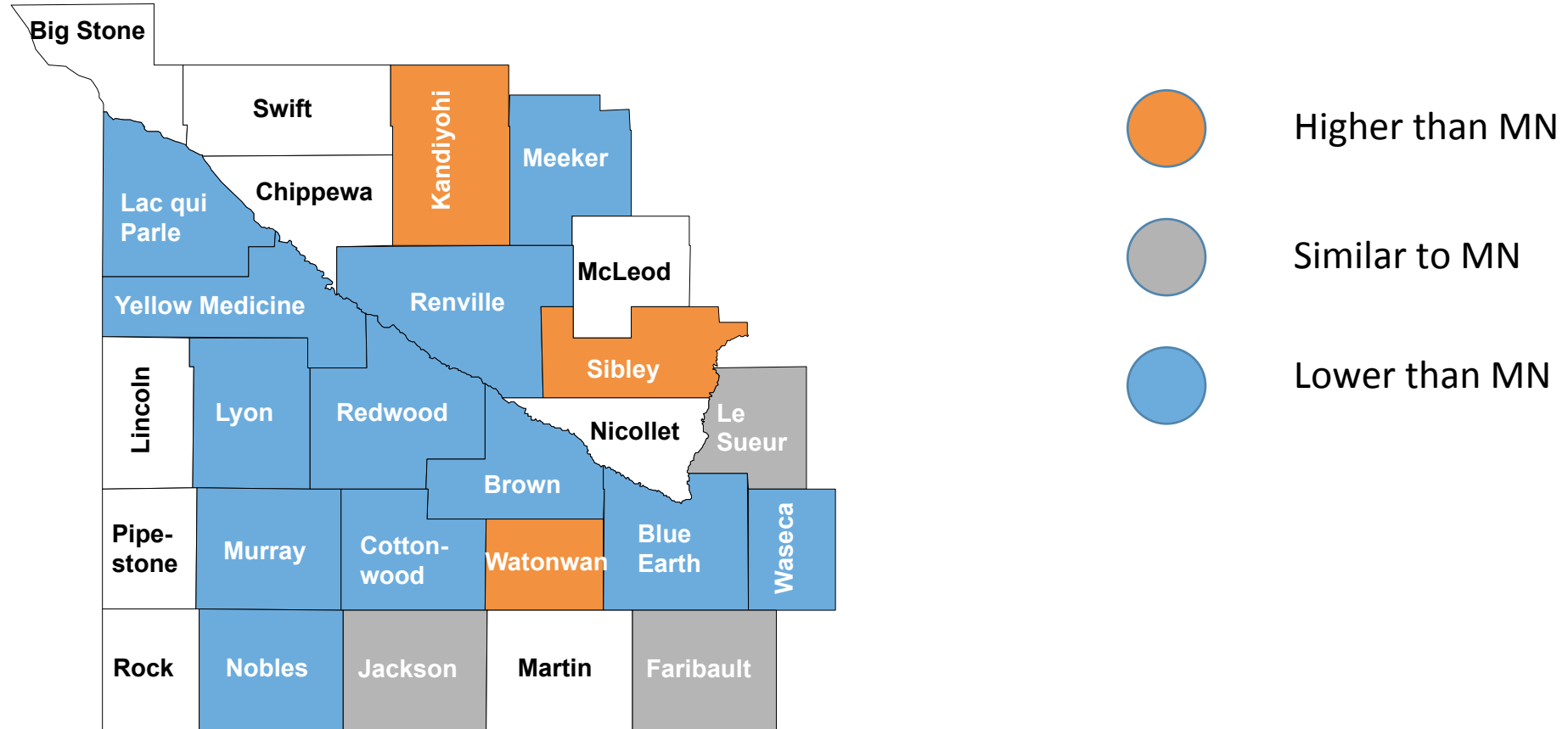
Past-Month Marijuana Use

9th Graders Reporting Any Past-Month Marijuana Use, by Year, MSS

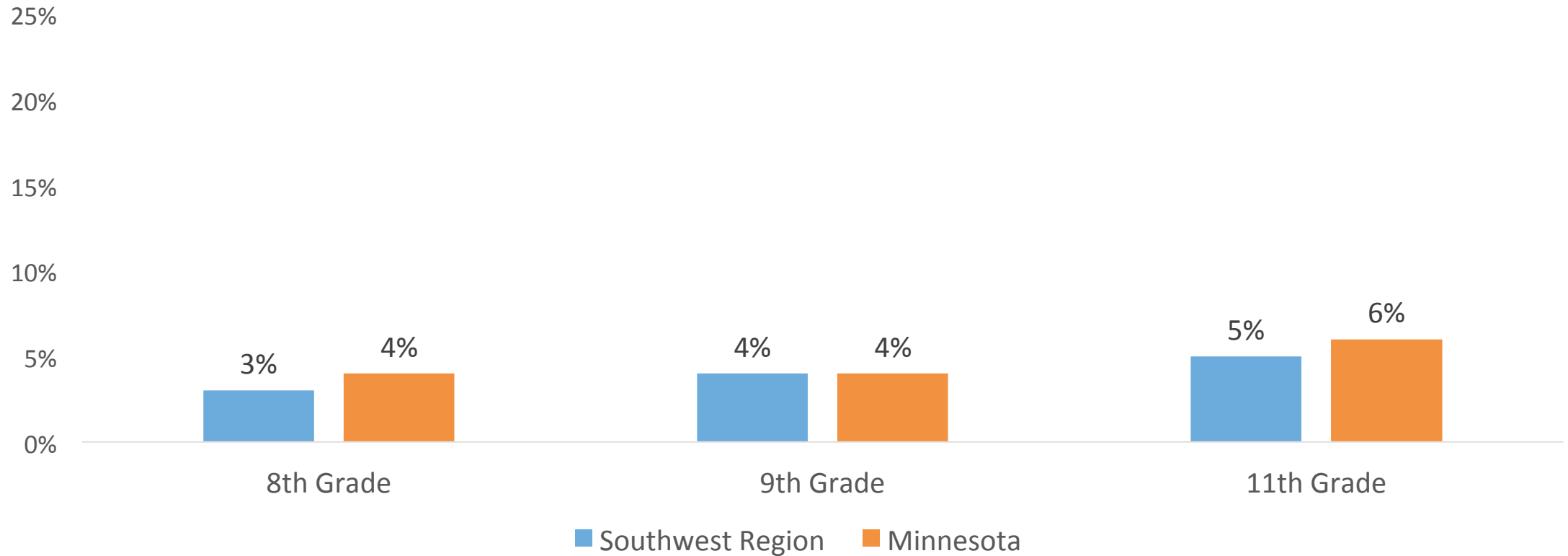

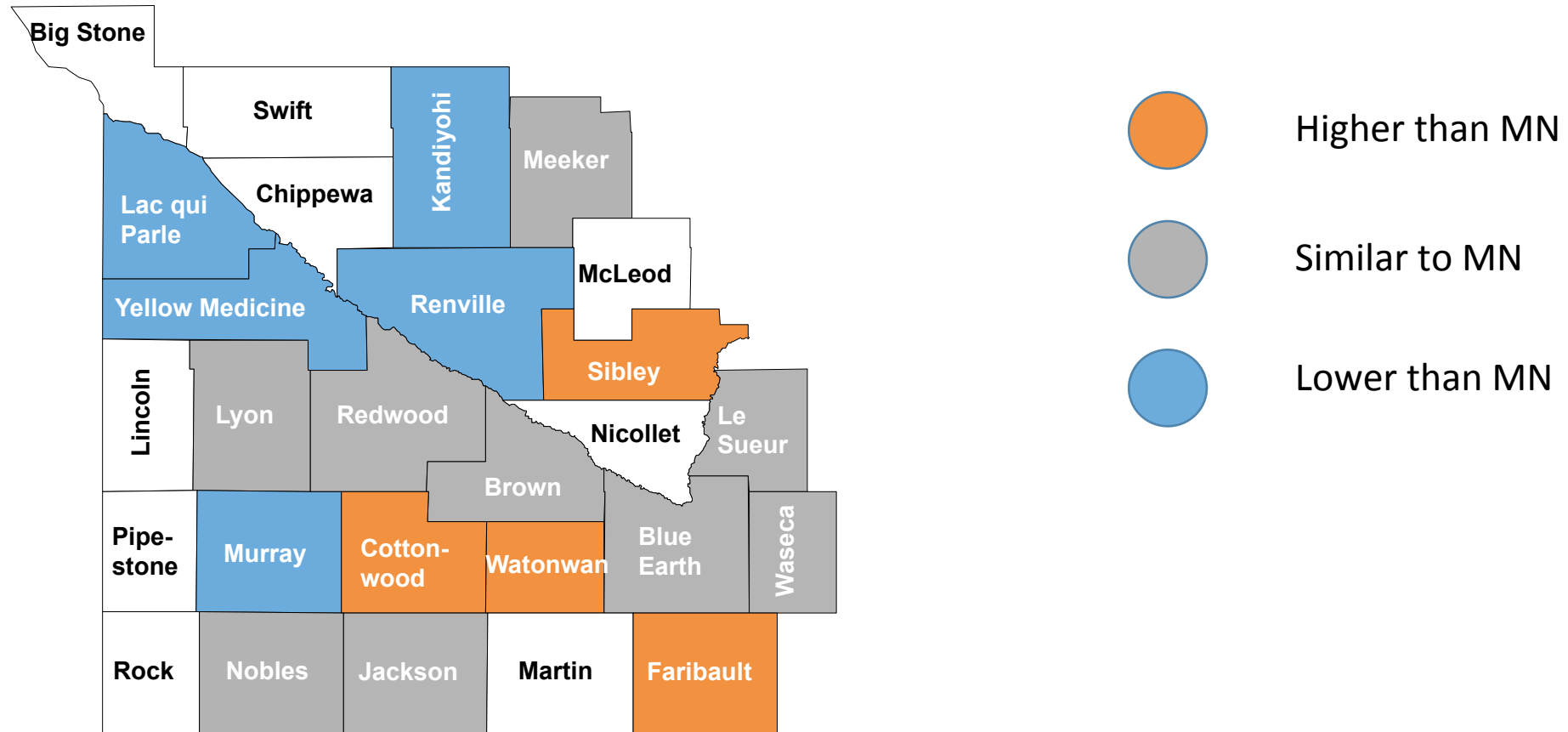


Past-Month Prescription Drug Misuse

Risk + Protective Factors

Definitions

Risk Factors

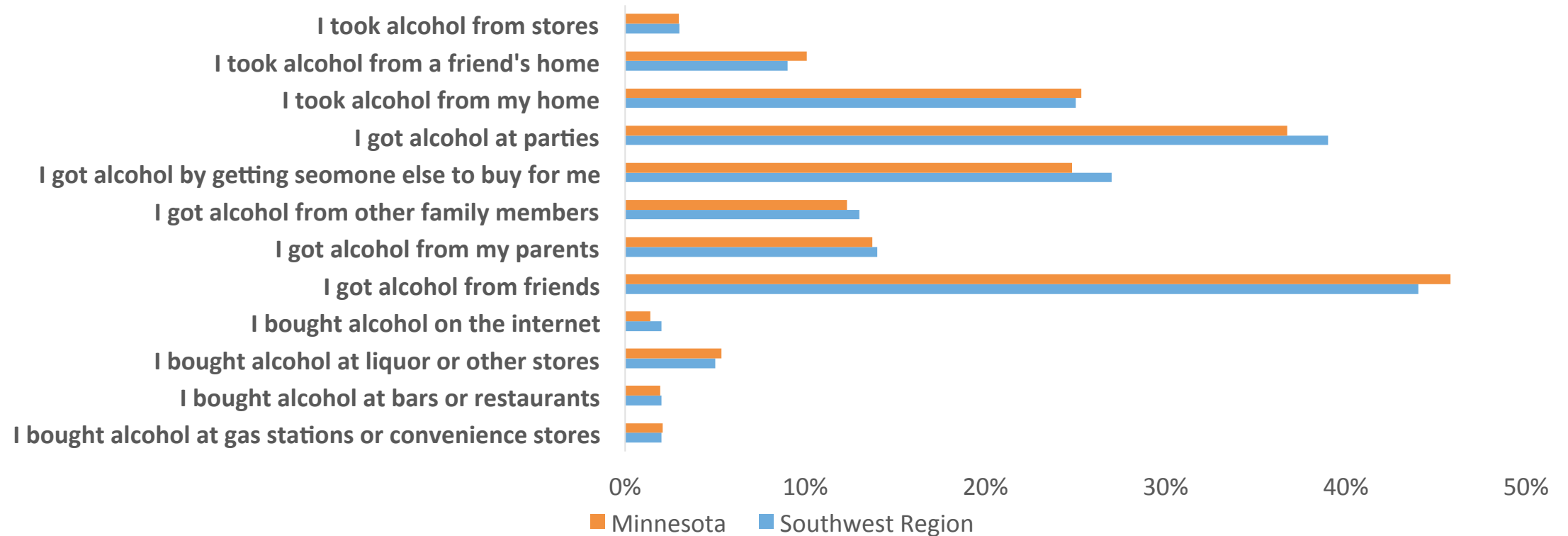
Individual characteristics and environmental influences associated with an **increased vulnerability** to the initiation, continuation, or escalation of substance use

Protective Factors

Individual resilience and other circumstances that are associated with a **reduction in the likelihood** of substance use

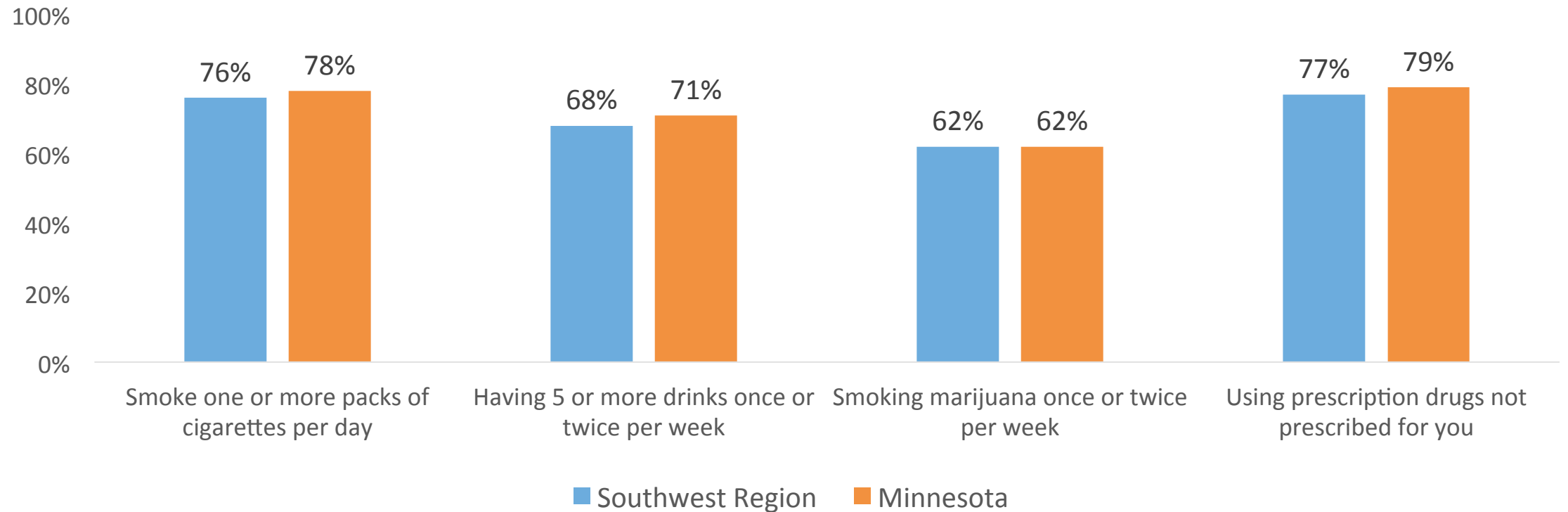

Alcohol Sources for 8th, 9th, + 11th Graders Reporting Any Past Month Use, 2013 MSS



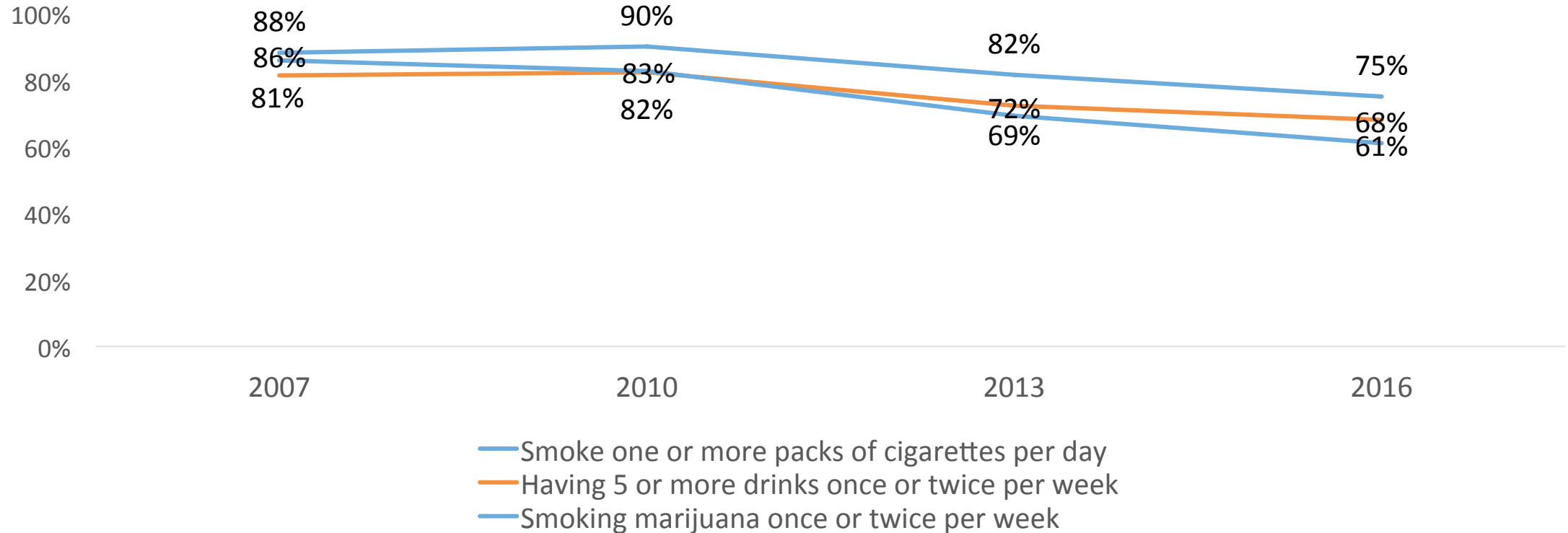
Perceived Risk of Harm

5th, 8th, 9th, + 11th Graders' Perceived Risk of Great or Moderate Harm from Substance Use, 2016 MSS




Southwest Region 9th Graders' Perceived Risk of Great or Moderate Harm from Substance Use, by Year (MSS)



Perceived vs Actual Use




69% of Southwest 11th graders think most students in their school drink monthly or more



17% of Southwest 11th graders report drinking themselves monthly or more



62% of Southwest 11th graders think most students in their school use marijuana monthly or more



10% of Southwest 11th graders report using marijuana themselves monthly or more

Risk Ratios

- Compare level of risk between two different student groups
- Show association, *not* causation
- Can vary from community to community
- Example:

$$\frac{\text{Students getting mostly A grades}}{\text{Students who didn't drink in the past month}} : \frac{\text{Students getting mostly A grades}}{\text{Students who DID drink in the past month}}$$

Comparison Groups

Be mindful of
the comparison
groups!

Southwest youth who think MOST students drink monthly or more often are **6.2x** more likely to report they drink monthly or more

vs

Southwest youth who drink monthly or more often are **2.0x** more likely to say they think MOST students drink monthly or more often

Southwest youth who reported being bullied in the past month are **2.3x** more likely to report past 30-day prescription drug misuse

vs

Southwest youth who reported past 30-day prescription drug misuse are **1.5x** more likely to report having been bullied in the past month

Alcohol Use

Students reporting NO past-month alcohol use were...

Almost 7x	Almost 9x	Tobacco
Over 11x	Almost 12x	Marijuana
Almost 9x	Almost 8x	Prescription drugs not prescribed for them

Students reporting NO past-month tobacco use were...

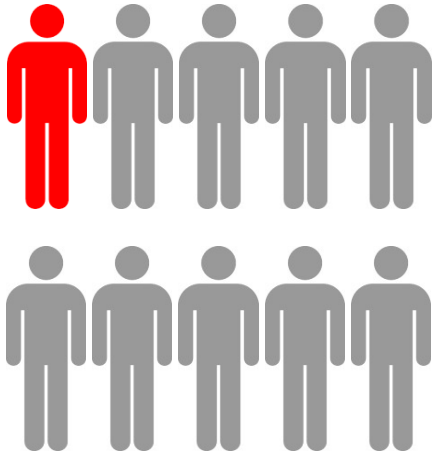

Over 7x	8x	Alcohol
Almost 17x	Over 16x	Marijuana
Over 7x	Almost 8x	Prescription drugs not prescribed for them

Mental Health



Suicidal Ideation

Just over 1 out of 10 Southwest (11.1%) + Minnesota (11.8%) 8th, 9th, + 11th graders reported past-year suicidal ideation

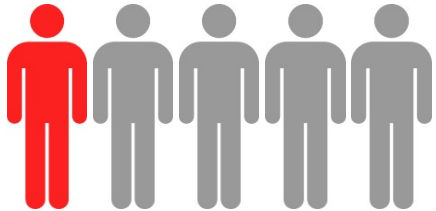


Southwest Region students reporting past-year suicidal ideation were:

- **2.3x** more likely to report alcohol use
- **2.7x** more likely to report tobacco use
- **3.4x** more likely to report marijuana use
- **4.4x** more likely to report Rx drug misuse

Depression

Almost 1 out of 5 Southwest (21%) + Minnesota (22%) 8th, 9th, + 11th graders reported past-year significant problems with feeling very depressed

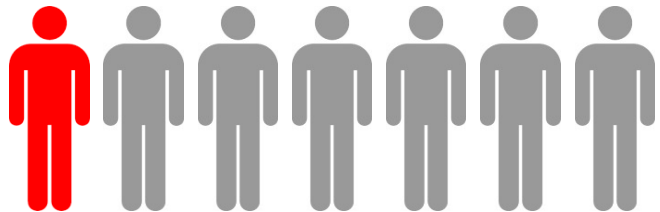


Southwest students reporting past-year significant problems with feeling very depressed were:

- **1.9x** more likely to report alcohol use
- **2.2x** more likely to report tobacco use
- **2.4x** more likely to report marijuana use
- **3.3x** more likely to report Rx drug misuse

Self-Harm

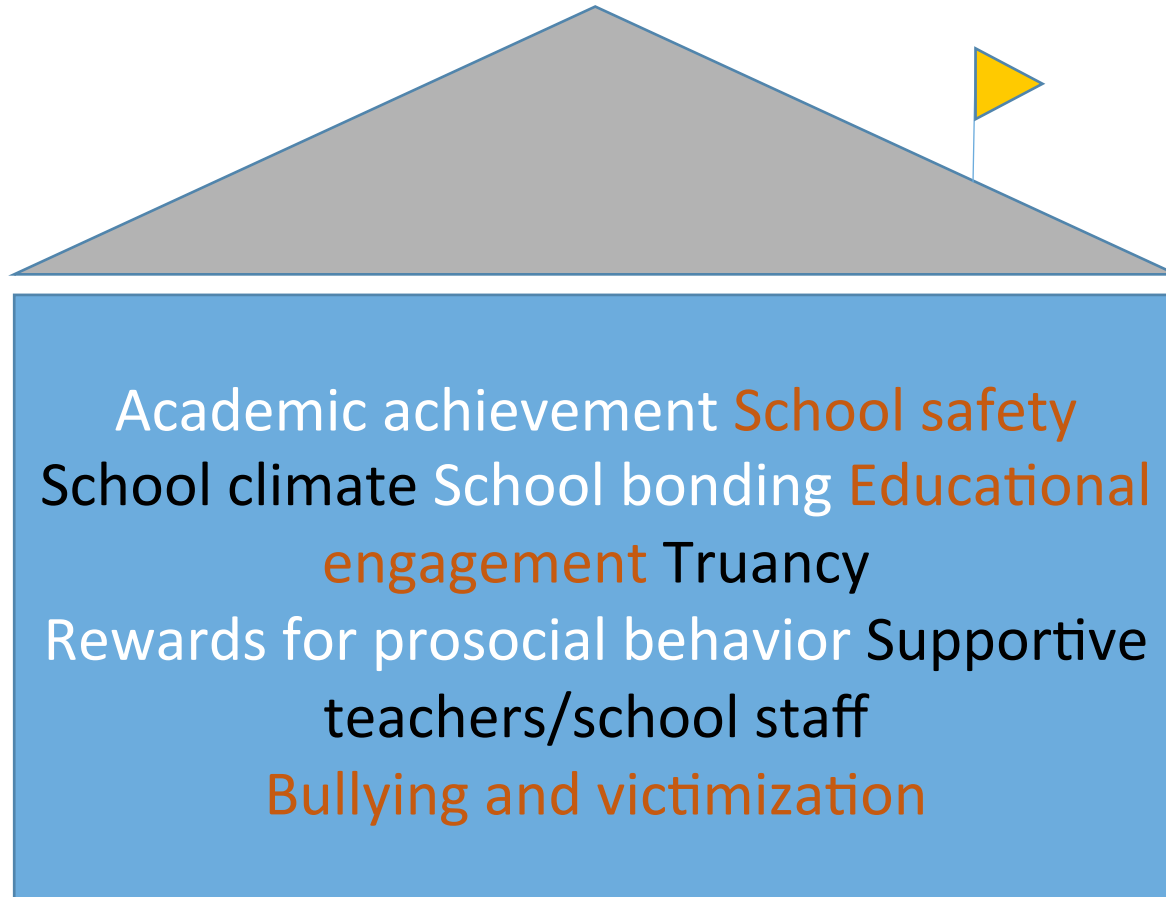
Roughly 1 out of 7 Southwest (15%) + Minnesota (16%) 8th, 9th, + 11th graders reported past-year self-harm



Southwest students reporting past-year self-harm were:

- **2.4x** more likely to report alcohol use
- **3.0x** more likely to report tobacco use
- **3.4x** more likely to report marijuana use
- **4.5x** more likely to report Rx drug misuse

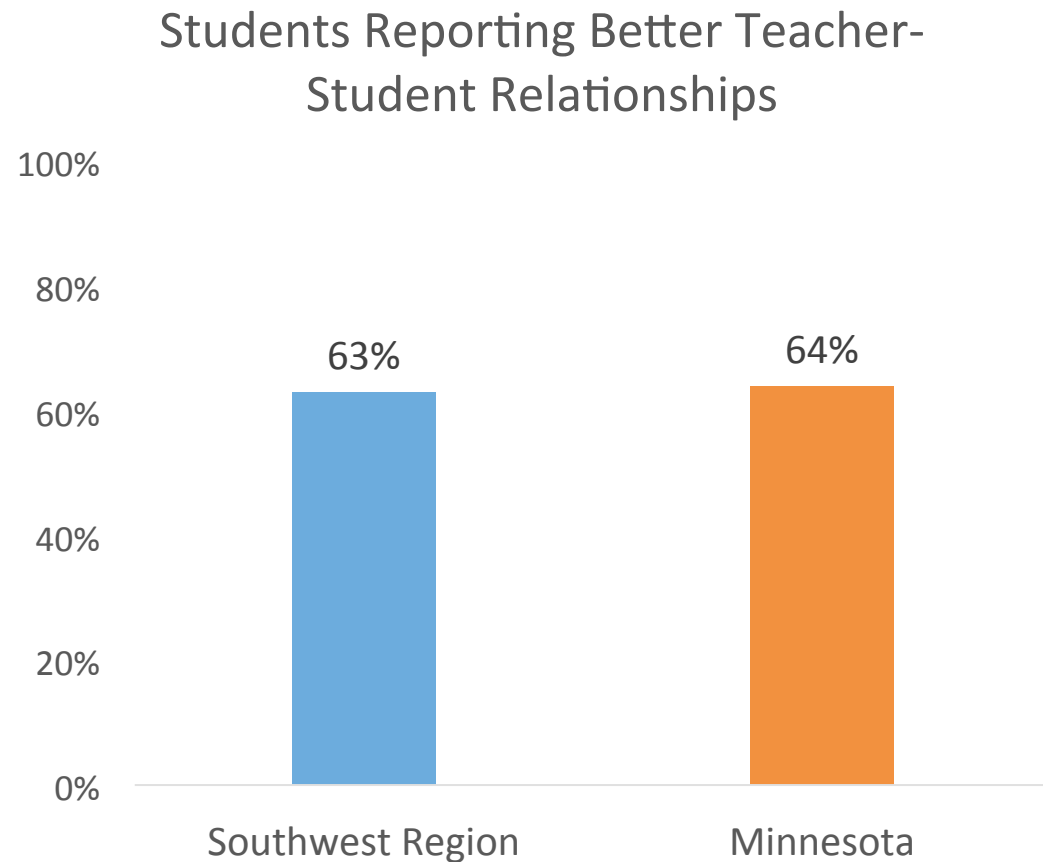
School



Teacher-Student Relationships

- Overall, adults at my school treat students fairly
- Adults at my school listen to the students
- The school rules are fair
- At my school, teachers care about students
- Most teachers at my school are interested in me as a person

Teacher-Student Relationships



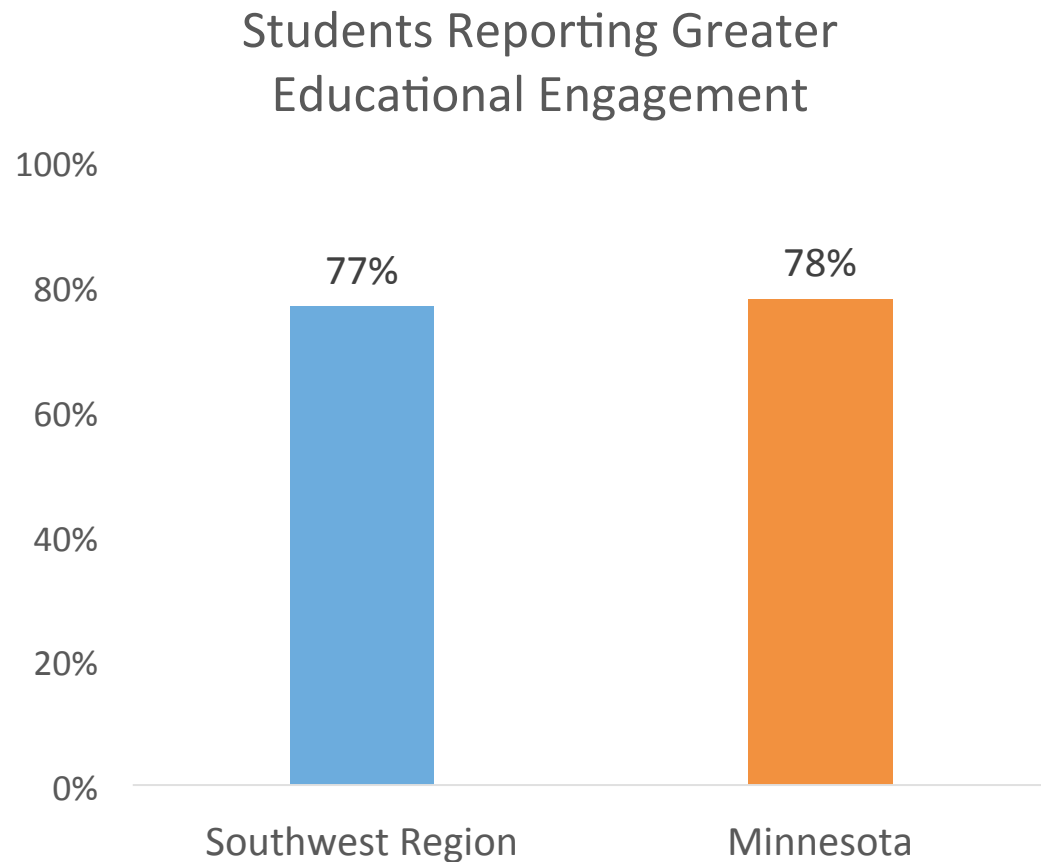
Southwest Region students reporting better teacher-student relationships were:

- **2.4x** less likely to report alcohol use
- **3.1x** less likely to report tobacco use
- **2.9x** less likely to report marijuana use
- **2.5x** less likely to report Rx drug misuse

Educational Engagement

- How often do you care about doing well in school?
- How often do you pay attention in class?
- How often do you go to class unprepared?
- If something interests me, I try to learn more about it.
- I think the things I learn at school are useful.
- Being a student is one of the most important parts of who I am.

Educational Engagement



Southwest Region students reporting greater educational engagement were:

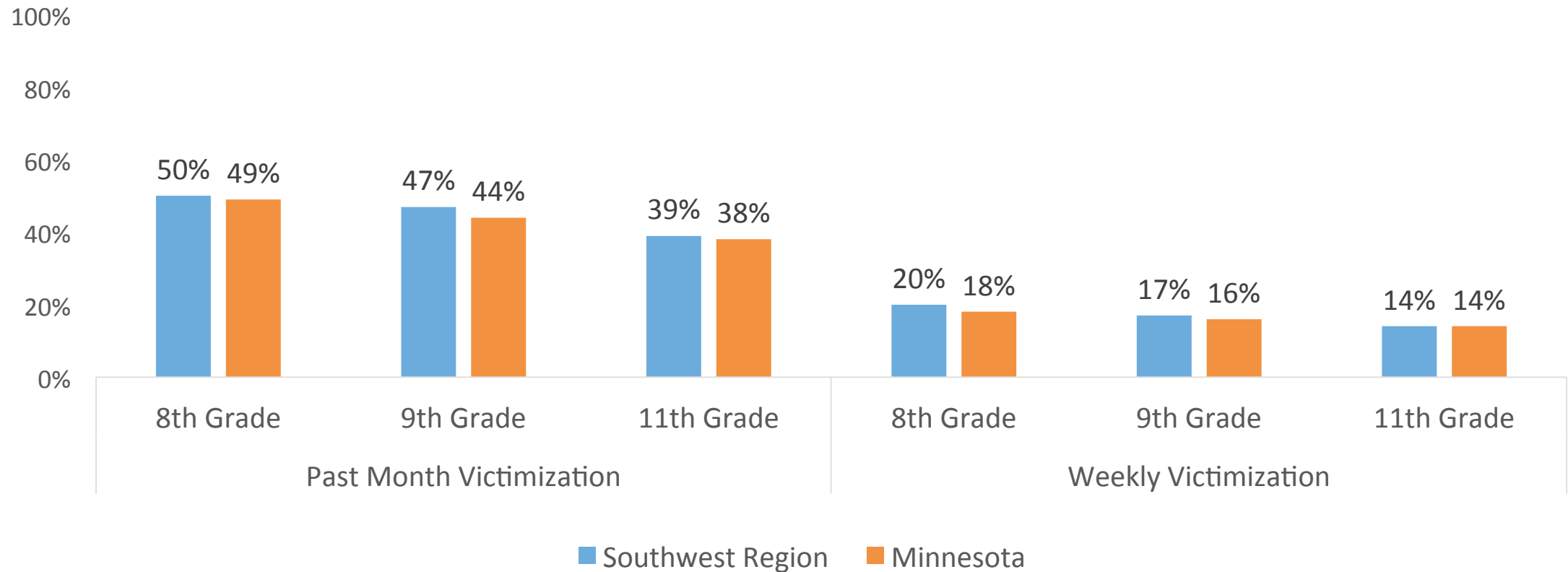
- **2.6x** less likely to report alcohol use
- **3.1x** less likely to report tobacco use
- **3.4x** less likely to report marijuana use
- **2.6x** less likely to report Rx drug misuse

Bullying

- Students spread mean rumors or lies about you once or more in past month
- Students excluded you from friends, other students, or activities in past month
- Students made sexual jokes, comments, or gestures towards you in past month
- Students pushed, shoved, slapped, hit or kicked you once or more in past month
- Students threatened to beat you up once or more in past month

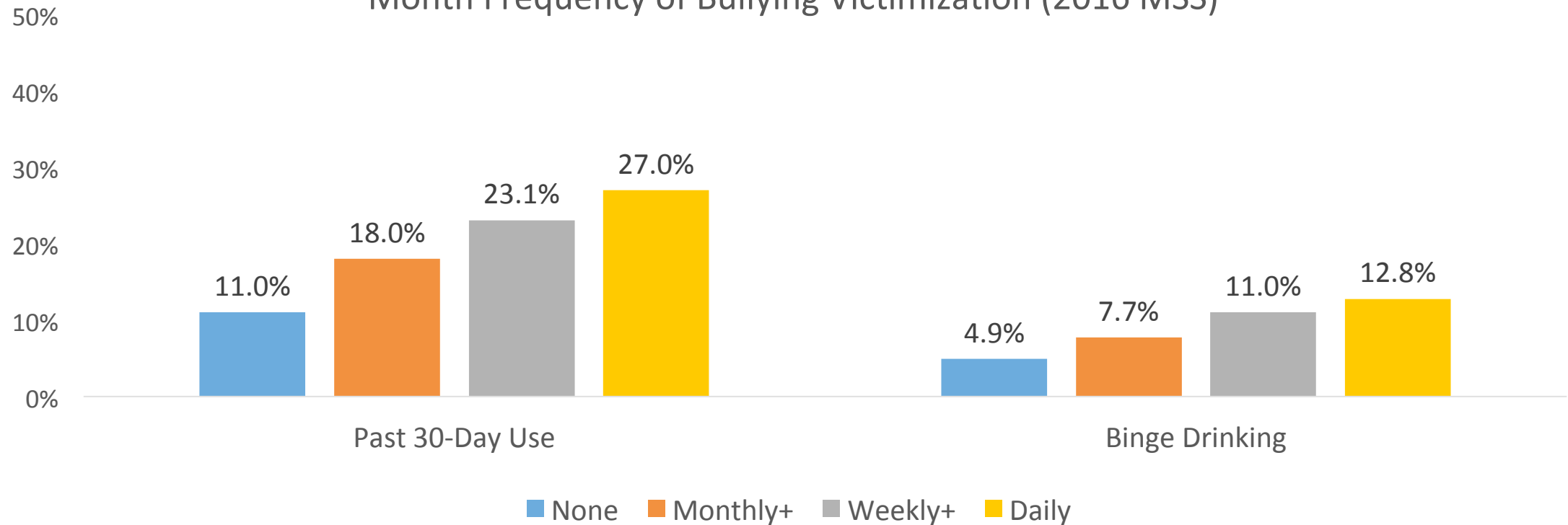
Students Reporting Bullying Victimization, by Frequency + Grade, 2016 MSS



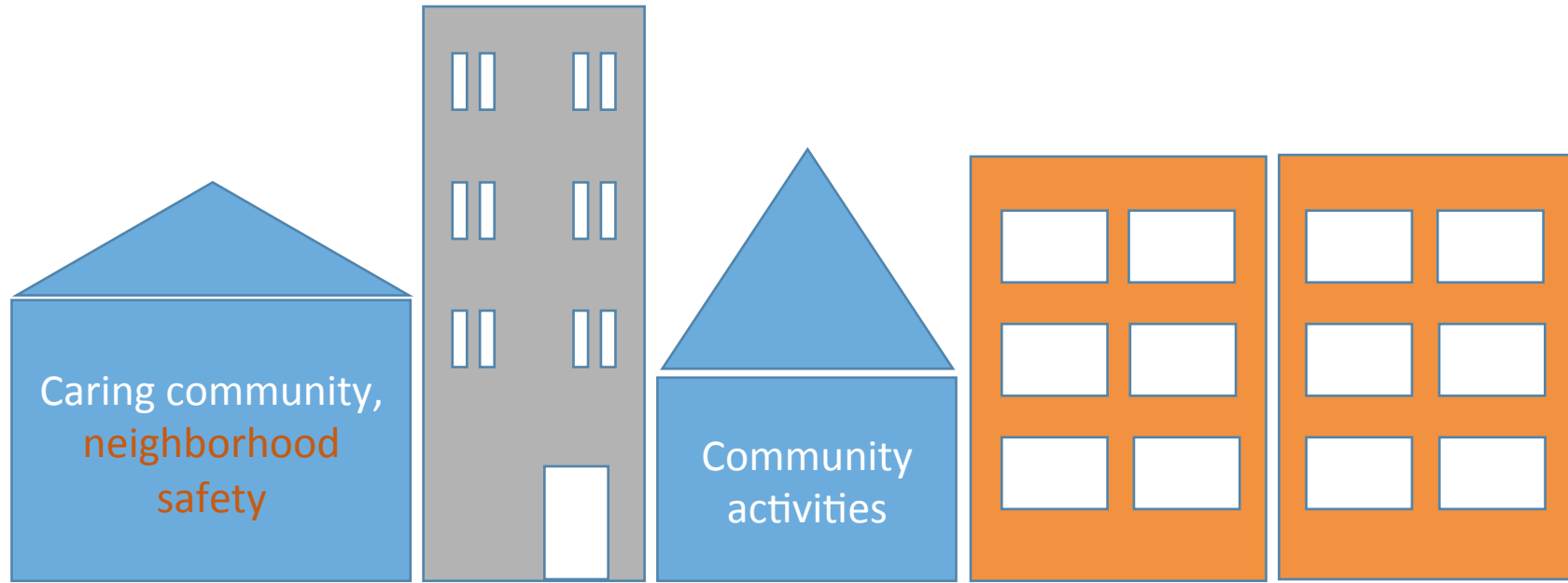
Bullying

Compared to Minnesota students who said they weren't bullied in the past month, those bullied were **3.4 times** more likely to report suicidal ideation

Minnesota Students Reporting Past Month Drinking + Binge Drinking, by Past Month Frequency of Bullying Victimization (2016 MSS)

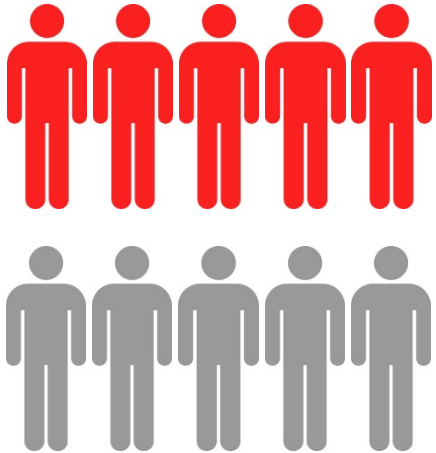


Community



Caring Community

Almost 5 of 10 Southwest 5th, 8th, 9th, + 11th graders say they think adults in their community care about them quite a bit or very much

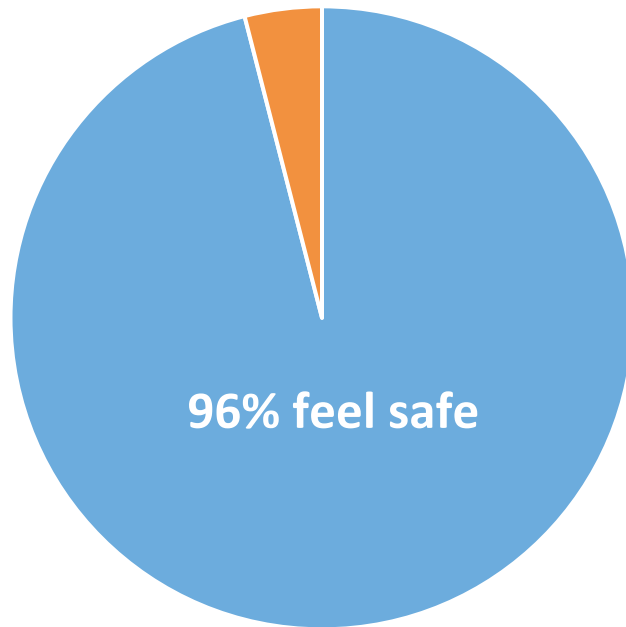


However, those who do feel their community cares were:

- **1.9x** less likely to report alcohol use
- **2.2x** less likely to report tobacco use
- **3.0x** less likely to report marijuana use
- **2.2x** less likely to report Rx drug misuse

Southwest 5th, 8th, 9th, + 11th
Graders Reporting They Feel Safe in
Their Neighborhood, 2016 MSS

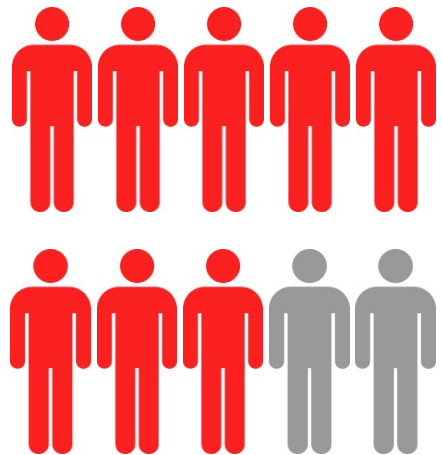


Southwest 8th, 9th, + 11th graders
who don't feel safe in their
neighborhood are:

- **1.6x** more likely to report alcohol use
- **2.0x** more likely to report tobacco use
- **2.0x** more likely to report marijuana use
- **3.8x** more likely to report Rx drug misuse

Participation in Community Activities

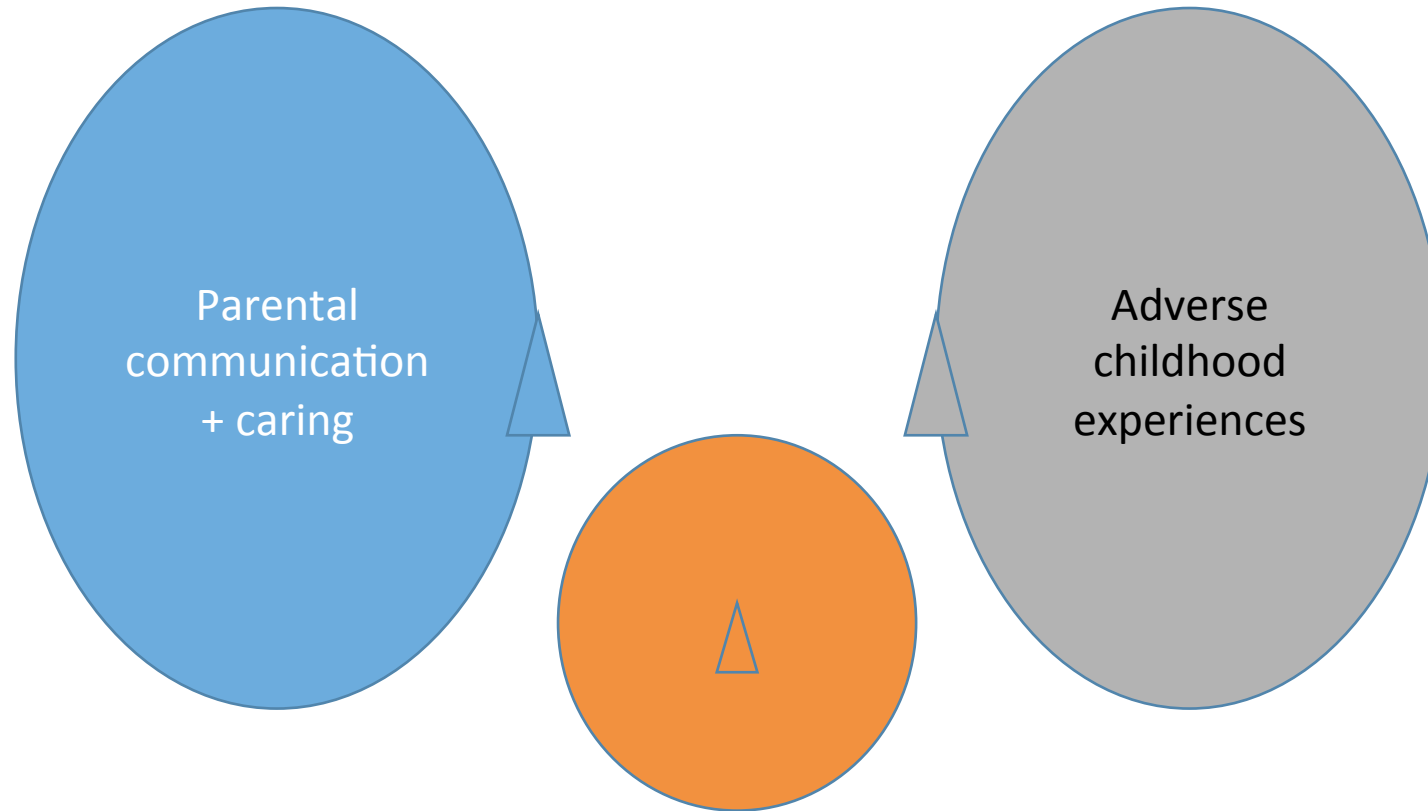
8 of 10 Southwest + Minnesota (81% for both) 5th, 8th, 9th, + 11th graders reported participating in community sports, clubs or programs, and/or religious activities at least once per week or more



Southwest 8th, 9th, + 11th reporting participation in community activities were:

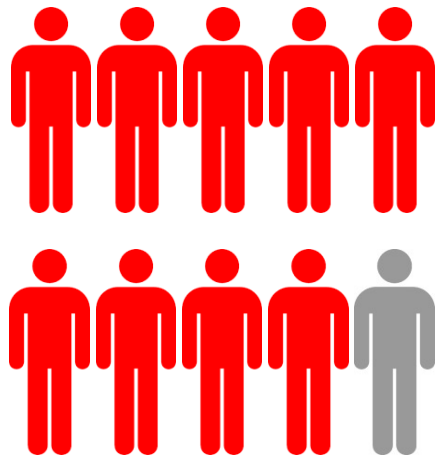
- **1.5x** less likely to report alcohol use
- **1.9x** less likely to report tobacco use
- **2.1x** less likely to report marijuana use
- **1.5x** less likely to report Rx drug misuse

Family



Parental Communication

9 out of 10 Southwest 5th, 8th, 9th, + 11th graders say they can talk to their mother and/or father all or most of the time about problems they are having



However, those who can't were:

- **1.8x** more likely to report alcohol use
- **2.1x** more likely to report tobacco use
- **2.6x** more likely to report marijuana use
- **2.5x** more likely to report Rx drug misuse

Parental Caring

- 9 out of 10 Southwest 5th, 8th, 9th, + 11th graders also say they feel their parents care about them quite a bit or very much
- But...that's not the same 9 out of 10 who can talk with their parents about problems—86% of Southwest students reported both parental communication and caring

Southwest 8th, 9th, + 11th who feel their parents care quite a bit or very much were:

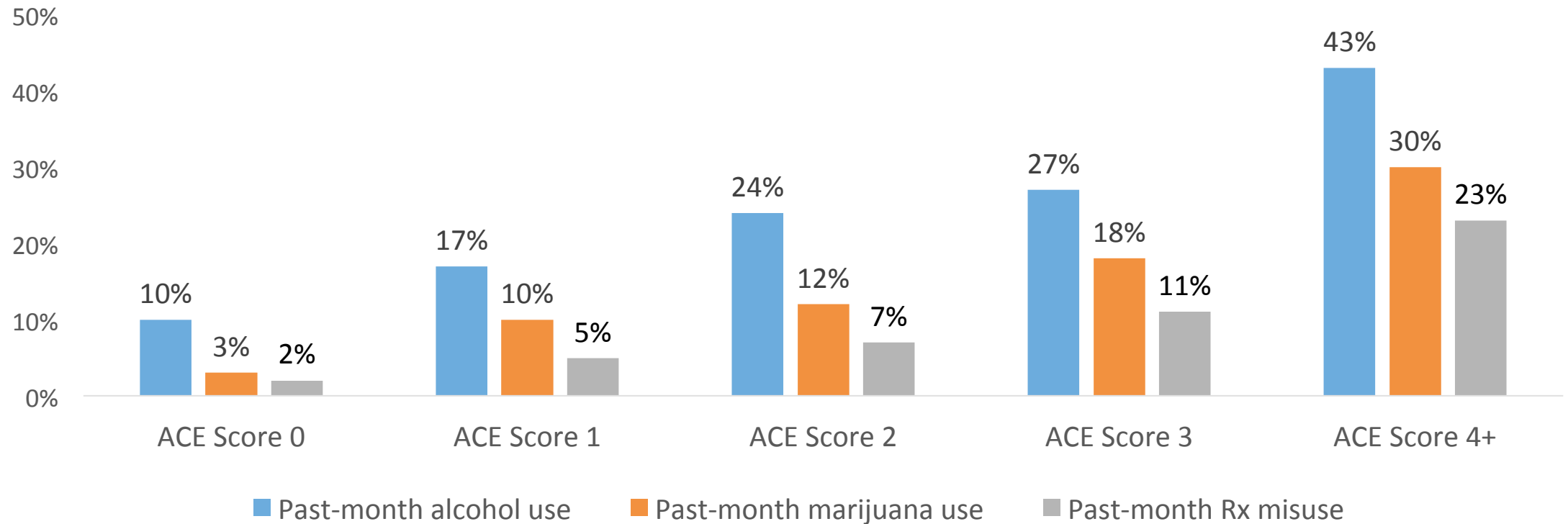
- **2.3x** less likely to report alcohol use
- **2.7x** less likely to report tobacco use
- **3.3x** less likely to report marijuana use
- **3.8x** less likely to report Rx drug misuse

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)

- Incarcerated parent/caregiver
- Living with someone who drinks too much alcohol
- Living with someone who uses illegal drugs or abuses prescription drugs
- Verbal abuse
- Physical abuse
- Household domestic abuse
- Sexual abuse
